Arts Grow SC - Grants Information

For Teachers

Arts Teacher Support

Up to \$3,000 per year, supports innovation in arts classrooms by helping arts teachers acquire supplies, materials, professional development, and tools/expertise.

Funding deadline: Rolling until 3/7/22, Apply by the first Monday of each month

Eligibility: Most public, private, and charter schools in S.C.

For Teaching Artists

Arts Education Projects*

Up to \$15,000 per year, supports quality K-12 arts education programs in both traditional arts education settings and through other organizations that utilize the arts to advance learning in children.

Funding deadline: Tentative FY23 deadline 3/15/22; details TBA

Eligibility: Most S.C. schools, nonprofit organizations (arts & non-arts), colleges and universities, and units of government

Arts Project Support

Up to \$2,500 per fiscal year, artists' and organizations' quality arts projects & programs and/or their commitment to improving themselves and/or their work artistically.

Funding deadline: Rolling, Apply at least six weeks before the project begins; Final deadline 4/15/22

Eligibility: Artists, nonprofit organizations, and units of government

For Districts

District Arts Support

Up to \$25,000 per year, supports school districts committed to implementing standards-based arts curricula and to making the arts an integral part of the basic curriculum and daily classroom instruction.

Funding deadline: Letter of Intent to apply deadline 2/15/22; contact kmotte@arts.sc.gov for letter of intent guidelines

Eligibility: Most S.C. school districts with a three-year arts education strategic plan and a part- or full-time arts coordinator

District Arts Coordinator Grant

Up to \$30,000 per year for 3 years, supports school districts in establishing or expanding the role of the district arts coordinator to ensure the development and/or implementation of a rigorous arts learning strategic plan.

Funding deadline: Letter of Intent to apply deadline 2/15/22; contact kmotte@arts.sc.gov for letter of intent guidelines

Eligibility: Most S.C. school districts

For Administrators

ABC Advancement Grant

Up to \$15,000 per year, supports ABC Certified Schools in their commitment to implementing standards-based arts curricula and to making the arts an integral part of the basic curriculum and daily classroom instruction.

Funding deadline: Tentative FY23 deadline 5/17/22; details TBA

Eligibility: ABC Certified Schools and FY21 ABC Advancement Grantees in Groups B & C

For Community Partners

General Operating Support (GOS)

No pre-set range of funds, helps strengthen arts organizations that bring ongoing arts experiences and services to individuals, communities, and other organizations throughout the state.

Funding deadline: The application deadline for FY23 has passed Eligibility: S.C. nonprofit arts organizations and units of government, who either have a primary mission focused on the arts or serve as the primary arts provider in their community

Operating Support for Small Organizations (OSS)

Up to \$2,500 per year, helps strengthen small organizations' ability to bring ongoing arts experiences and services to individuals, communities, and other organizations throughout the state.

Funding deadline: The application deadline for FY23 has passed

Eligibility: S.C. nonprofit organizations & units of government with a total arts expense budget of \$75,000 or less and at least one completed fiscal year of programming

Summer Arts Education Projects Grant

Up to \$50,000 (\$25,000 per summer - 2022 and 2023), supports arts education programs for K-12 students between school years, through both traditional and non-traditional providers.

Funding deadline: The application deadline for FY23 has passed

Eligibility: Most S.C. nonprofit organizations (arts & non-arts), colleges and universities, and units of government.

Term Arts Education Project Grant

Up to \$30,000 (\$15,000 per term 2022-2023 and 2023-2024, excludes summer), supports arts education programs for K-12 students during the school term, through traditional and non-traditional providers.

Funding deadline: Receiving applications from 2/1/22 - 3/29/22 Eligibility: Most S.C. nonprofit organizations (arts & non-arts), colleges and universities, and units of government.
